
Instructions for sewing

T-shirt «School»

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Materials and notions

- cotton lycra jersey
- knit fusible interfacing
- twilled ribbon 10 mm (3/8") wide (optional, depending on the processing way chosen)
- shirt snap buttons 9,5 mm (3/8") 3 pcs
- matching thread
- Jersey 70-80 or Stretch 70-80 needles

If you are not sure about the fit of the garment, it is recommended to sew a muslin with similar properties (elasticity, thickness, drape) first. This will allow you to adjust the length, width and fit of the garment and save time.


To find out how long a piece of fabric to take, you should place the pattern pieces onto the table, the floor or bedspread, pre-measured width equal to half the width of the selected fabric. Place the pieces, caring the direction of the grain line, their number, i.e., the way you will place them when cutting. Measure the length of the pattern pieces fit, add to this length 5% for the fabric shrinkage this will be the required amount of fabric for the project. Before beginning your sewing project, wash the fabric in warm

water, dry and iron it.

Cutting layout: Print and glue all the paper patterns. When printing, do not forget to check the size of the test square. Put the paper pattern pieces onto the fabric. It is important to check that the grain is straight. Pin the paper pattern pieces to the fabric gently and cut the fabric along outline. Note: seam allowances are already included. Transfer all the marks from the pattern onto the wrong side of your fabric.




Cutting layout



T-SHIRT PIECES:


- 1. front cut 1 on the fold
- 2. back cut 1 on the fold
- 3. sleeve cut 2
- 4. upper collar cut 1 on the fold 5. under collar - cut 1 on the fold
- **6.** placket cut 2



PIECES TO INTERFACE:

- Green knit fusible interfacing
- under collar
- upper collar
- plackets

4-thread serger stitch

If you do not have a serger, you can use stretch stitches available on your sewing machine, or at least, a zigzag stitch.



3-thread serger stitch

If you do not have a serger, you can replace it with an overedge stitch, or a zigzag stitch.



flat lock stitch


If you do not have a coverstitch machine, the flat seam can be performed with a) a twin needle on a sewing machine, b) decorative stretch seam on a sewing machine, c) finish the seams with serger and stitch them with a straight stitch.

Plackets, both collar pieces are cut rough, i. e., expand the allowances at about 10-15 mm (3/8 - 9/16"). Do it because after you duplicate the piece, it can shrink significantly. Duplicate the pieces.

Cut the plackets and both collars exactly along the patterns and transfer the marks from the patterns onto the pieces.






Pin the upper and under collars with right sides together. Stitch the pieces 7 mm (1/4") in from the edge.




Trim the collar seam allowances to 3-4 mm (1/8") with pinking shears. Turn the collar out to the right side. Press it forming a roll towards the under collar.














With right sides together, pin the placket raw edges to the split, aligning the edges. Working from the right side, stitch the plackets exactly along the marking. Stitch 7 mm (1/4") in from the edge.








With right sides together pin the front and the back along the shoulder edges. Serge them. Press the seam allowances flat towards the front.






Pin the collar to the garment neckline right side (with under collar faced the garment), aligning the marks and edges. Fold the plackets in half to the right side atop the collar. Stitch with a straight stitch 7 mm (1/4") in from the edges.

Align and pin the placket lower edges and the seam allowances of the split for the placket. Right placket is sandwiched between the garment and the left placket. Align the placket folds and the split corners. Stitch them along the marking. Make sure the right side is good, no folds are formed.

T-SHIRT CONSTRUCTION





Finish the placket lower edges with the serger. Tie the thread tails and hide them into the seam using a thick needle with a large eye. Press the seam allowances down.



Baste the twilled ribbon free edge to the garment, covering the serged seam. Stitch the twilled ribbon from one placket to the other 1 mm (1/16") away from the edge. Press the neckline.





Pin or baste the placket free edges.



T-SHIRT CONSTRUCTION





Edgestitch the placket over the perimeter 1 mm (1/16") away from the attaching seam. Press it.





With right sides together, pin the sleeve into the armscye aligning all the marks. Serge it in place. Press the seam allowances towards the front and the back. Repeat the process for the other sleeve.

Pin the back and the front along the side seam with right sides together. Pin the sleeve along the side seam with right sides together. Serge them. To avoid bulk, place the sleeve attaching seam allowances in different directions. Press the seam allowances towards the front. Repeat the process for the other side seam.


<u>NOTE.</u> It is recommended to make a fitting and assess the fit, length, and easeover-body. When fitting, consider the folded lower hem width and the sleeve lower hem width.

Fold the garment lower hem to the wrong side at 20 mm (13/16") and press it. You can hand-baste the edge. Coverstitch the lower hem. Tie the thread tails on the wrong side and hide them into the seam. Press again.



Fold the sleeve lower hems to the wrong side at 15 mm (9/16") and press them. You can hand-baste the sleeve edges. Coverstitch the lower hems. Tie the thread tails on the wrong side and hide them into the seam. Press them again.



Transfer the marks for the snap buttons from the pattern onto the placket. Attach the shirt snap buttons with a press.

Remove the basting stitches, trim the thread tails, and press the garment. The T-shirt is ready.
